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About the Category:

The Australian Government Community Partnerships Landcare Award acknowledges groups, networks, or organisations that have demonstrated leadership and achievement in landcare related activities as a result of working in partnership with others in their community.

Who can be Nominated:

Nominations are open to groups, networks, First Nations organisations, natural resource management organisations, research organisations, local government, farmers, landowners, land managers, schools, youth groups and community-led environmental care groups.

Selection Criteria:

1. Describe the group, network, or organisation being nominated, including their involvement in landcare-related activities within their community. Highlight the motivations and duration of their participation in community-based landcare efforts.
2. Explain how the nominee has displayed leadership and achieved notable milestones in landcare-related activities within their community. Provide examples of their contributions that have had a positive impact on the community's natural resource management and environmental stewardship.
3. Describe how the nominee has effectively engaged and collaborated with the community in landcare-related initiatives. Highlight their efforts to foster partnerships, networks, or alliances that have strengthened community involvement and collective action in landcare. Describe the tangible impact of the nominee's landcare-related activities on the community, emphasising environmental, social, or economic outcomes.
4. In 25 words (2-3 sentences), summarise your nomination, highlighting the key messages that best describe why this nominee should be recognised for their outstanding achievements to landcare.
